1. What from Sunday's message stood out to you the most? Why?
2. What is a time you have confirmed God's clear instruction to you? How did you confirm God's leading?
3. What is the significance of Joseph leaving in haste, or "that very night" when he heard God's instructions? How important is it that we respond in "haste" to God's instructions to us?
4. Is there an action that you have been putting off, even though God has clearly spoken direction or right action?
5. What significance do you find that "out of Egypt I called my son" to have? How surprised are to find that it's not found in Genesis or Exodus and instead from Hosea? What is the prophet's purpose in identifying Jesus as Israel?
6. The hope that Matthew is trying to give us is sourced in the prophet Jeremiah. Chapter 31 points out that God is establishing a kingdom, which gives us hope as we face the difficulties of our day! When all hope feels lost, God has provided us hope. Is there a situation you're dealing with that needs this perspective?
7. Remember to pray for one who has not made Jesus their King! What can you do this week to encourage or open the door of conversation towards this end?
8. Please continue to pray for God to call and raise up individuals to serve in full-time vocational ministry. Maybe it's you?
