1. Read through the accounts of the crucifixion in each of the gospels. (Matthew 26:36 - 27; Luke 22:47 - 23; Mark 15; John 18-19.
2. What do this passage reveal about God?
3. What does this passage reveal about us?
4. Jesus remained purposeful in accomplishing what God had purposed Him to accomplish. What do you feel your purpose is, and how are you accomplishing it?
5. What distractions have you identified that might take your focus off of accomplishing your purpose?
6. Read John 3:16; Ephesians 2:8; Romans 10:9; Acts 38; Mark 16:16; John 14:15; Romans 5:8. Jesus committed himself to us? Have you committed yourself to Him? What does the Bible teach about committing our life to Him? Discuss any questions you have with one of the Elders, or another trusted follower of Jesus.
7. Stop and Pray for someone you know right now who has not committed their life to Christ.
8. What phrase are you looking forward to hearing from Jesus most and why?
9. What phrase that Jesus spoke from the cross most resonated with you, or that you found challenging? Why?
10. After spending the last six weeks looking at the crucifixion of Jesus, are the words in Matthew 16:24-25 different for you? Why or Why not? "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."
