6. What was the outcome of Paul seeing his imprisonment as an opportunity to share the gospel?
7. Do you have something going on where someone is helping you currently? Do you know whether that person Trusts Jesus for eternity? If not, what's keeping you from asking? If they do trust in Jesus what are some ways you can encourage them?
