Crossroads International Student Ministries

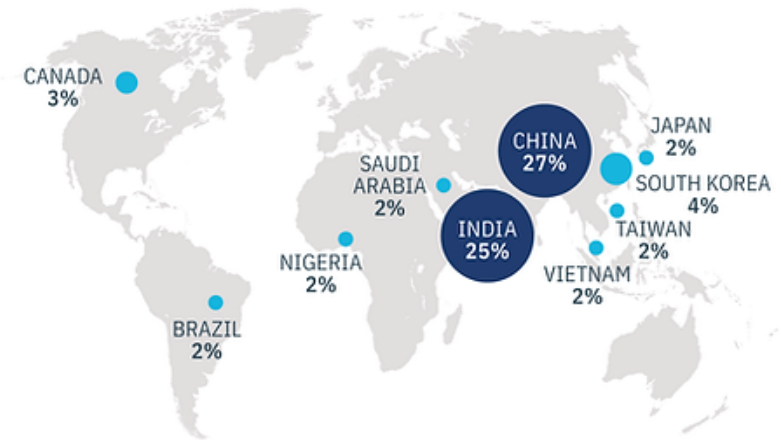
CISM exists to awaken the church to mobilize the church to share Jesus' love by serving and discipling internationals coming to universities in the U.S.A. CISM was launched on October 10, 2010 (10-10-10) by Greg Swinney, who had been serving as campus minister for Christian Student Fellowship in Nebraska for the previous 25 years, along with a board of directors, who shared the vision of reaching international students.

The University campus is the modern day crossroads of the world. It brings people of all nationalities and cultures together into a marketplace of modern thought. Today 1.2 million international students are walking on our campuses pursuing their studies, but also searching for purpose and meaning. They come from more than 200 countries (65% of which are restrictive and/or hostile to the gospel). Enrollment of these students is growing by 8-9% each year. Many of these future leaders of the world are eager to develop friendships and learn from our culture; it's a wonderful opportunity to introduce them to Jesus.

CISM is training, equipping, supporting, and uplifting campus ministries, churches, and individuals to reach out and connect with international students.

Mike Kerrick, newly appointed director (because of Greg Swinney's retirement) is excited and hoping/planning to launch 30 new international ministries by the year 2030.
